BACK TO PAPYRUS

Papyrus Australia, the developer of a technology that utilises fibre from the waste trunk of the banana plant to produce paper and timber products, says it is now able to produce commercial quantities of fibreboard and veneer products for export from its Walkamin factory in Far North Queensland.

The world-first technology takes an otherwise unused waste material to produce high-value paper, cardboard, veneer and fibreboard products. The fibre, branded 'Beleaf', is both water-resistant and fire-retardant.
