

## Papyrus plant back on track

BANANA-waste paper maker Australia Papyrus has resumed testing and production trials at its Walkamin production plant in Queensland.

In its quarterly report released on Friday, the Adelaide firm said it was confident of achieving continuous production at the plant by September.

It said as a result of a dispute with a contractor, the commissioning of the production line had been delayed, meaning it was unable to meet its obligations with partners World Future Fibre, Hayot and 3W Tout Bois.

"The company remains positive concerning its continuing negotiations with the respective partners, in the hope that satisfactory arrangements can be agreed for the future," it said.
